NARROMINE

Narromine is a rural based community with a population of around 3,000. It has a hospital, doctors, pre-school, schools, day care, sporting groups, craft/hobby groups, men's shed and is situated on the Macquarie River half an hour drive west of Dubbo on the Mitchell Highway. Dubbo is the closest major centre with base hospital, private hospital, specialist services, several schools including one boarding school, regional airport, many shopping centres, transport hub and general industry hub for the western area of NSW



TRANGIE

Trangie is a rural based community with a population of around 1,000. It has a community care hospital, a doctor, schools, pre-school and day-care centre, sporting clubs, craft/hobby groups, men's shed, and is situated half an hour west of Narromine on the Mitchell highway.



DANDALOO

Dandaloo is a small rural community located on the banks of the Bogan River near the small rural town of Albert, 45 mins drive from Trangie and a 60min drive from Narromine.
