Title: Look in the mirror **Passage**: James 1:16-27

Look in the mirror and see:

1. We are his because of him 1:16-18

2. ... therefore, we are outstanding 1:19-21

3. ... because we listen and do! 1:22-25

4. ...e.g.: our tongue, our care, and our heart 1:26-27

Introduction

- You know, if anyone thinks Christianity is just a nice little component on the side of our lives so we
 have something to do on Sundays and feel some sort of connection with God and other Christians...
 we are going to be SO challenged by this Epistle of James.
- Last week James began by helping us see the big picture when it comes to **trials**... that they can lead to **maturity in Christ** which is exactly what the true Christian wants and end with the **crown of life** precisely what the true Christian looks **forward to**
- We saw **trials** are different to **temptation** which can lead to **sin** and if unchecked **death**. //
- I hope that picture helped you last **week** even in the midst of that trial you may be facing right **now**... that the Lord will use it... to bring you to maturity in him... //
- But now that he has dealt with trials... we begin in earnest, James' purpose for the book do you recall? We saw in the last verse of the book what he does throughout is bring people back who have wandered from the truth...
- He wants to wake up those who have become complacent
- He wants so to shake up those who say they are Christians but there's simply no evidence of that in their lives...
- It seems as though he's observed loads of people identifying **as Christians** or **with Christians** but wow you should hear how they **speak**, or see how quickly they get **angry**... or you should see the way they listen to the Scriptures but never do what they **say**... or should see their total lack of **care** for the **vulnerable**...
- These passages in James will be searching... I think we all have to honestly search our hearts and lives
 and listen carefully for how God is speaking to us...
- So I've called today's message "Look in the mirror" and this is where we are heading

Look in the mirror and see:

- 1. We are his because of him 1:16-18
- 2. ... therefore, we are outstanding 1:19-21
- 3. ... because we listen and do! 1:22-25
- 4. ...e.g.: our tongue, our care, and our heart 1:26-27
- The Bible you see, is pictured here as a mirror
- As we look into it read it reflect on it we see ourselves more clearly we understand ourselves
 we see ourselves for who we really are....

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- And as you'd be mad to look in the mirror in the morning and see your hair out of place and some toothpaste still on the side of your face and do <u>NOTHING</u>...
- ...so we'd be mad to look into God's word, see things that obviously need addressing and then walk away doing nothing... //
- So look in the mirror and see

1. We are his because of him 1:16-18

- What do I mean by that...?
- Vv16-18 start by pointing out that every good and perfect gift if from above... **that** is what comes from God...
- In the context of last week's passage **trials** yes will come and God will use them for good; but **temptations NO** these do **NOT** come from **God**.
- God is not like someone lurking in the shadows, out to get us... whose motives or actions we might **question**....
- He's up **front**... **dependable reliable**... and will only 'send down' as it were, that which is **good**... that which is **FOR** our **good**! even though we might not understand it at the time...
- And this is seen so very clearly when you consider his ultimate and perfect and wonderful gift... have
 a look with me at v18 He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of
 first fruits of all he created.
- How is it that we have been born anew... how is it that we have been made children of God??
- ALL and ONLY his work!
- Our **new birth** our **status** as his **children** it his **choice** his **gift**...! We are **his**, because of **him**.... And him **alone**! //
- ...and notice the **purpose**... He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of **first fruits** of all he created.
- Well you farmers will know about first fruits... if good they set the pattern or standard of what is
 to come they are the promise of what is to come!
- As God's first fruits, // we are the promise of his transformed people.... We are to stand out in this world... stand out as his chosen, unique, called people...
- Stand out as his **children** showing his **character** sharing his **love** reflecting his **compassion**...
- And "fistfights" also has the idea that we will see more as we share Jesus for life so there will be more people whom God calls to new birth through the word of truth!! ///
- But let's explore that a little more the concept of us **standing out** as God's **first fruits**:

2. ... therefore, we are outstanding 1:19-21

- That is, we are to stand out in the world.
- You know when I watch TV, or a movie, or spend too much time on social media... the language, the
 hating, the critical spirit, the total inability to disagree with another person with patience, respect love and understanding simply astonishes me....

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- And then I actually become disturbed when I see the way many Christians some of whom I know –
 also act online with no discernible difference from those who aren't Christians!
- That attitude to others, **dismissing** what others are **saying**... harsh criticism... sometimes **language**... from Christians! -
- I find distressing...
- Contrast this with what James challenges us with here: v19 have a look *My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,* ²⁰ because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.
- Someone once said we've been given two ears yet only one mouth and that is at least the ratio we should use of hearing vs speaking!
- I'm all too quick to jump in and say something... sometimes speaking over someone else as they speak!... because I'm simply not listening!
- And then what about slow to become angry?
- That's the very nature of God, isn't it?? Psalm 103:8 The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love...
- I'm all too quick in anger sometimes... //
- It was the USA counsellor pastor Larry Crabb who taught me years ago that anger is about **blocked goals**... there's something you've put your mind to **doing** or **having** and something's getting in the **way** of you getting what you want, so you become **angry! You lose it!**
- And of course as James says anger does not produce **righteousness** or **right living** or promote **right relationship** with **God** or anyone **else**! //
- No by way of complete contrast v21 we are to get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.
- Our lives are to stand out... because we **listen** more than **speak**.... Because we are (after the nature of our heavenly Father) ... **slow** to become **angry**...
- ...and we are to stand totally apart from the moral filth and evil which is all around us... everywhere
 we turn... every channel, every movie, every sit-com; every radio station... by receiving, accepting,
 welcoming... the transforming word of truth which God has planted in us....
- ...we open ourselves up to God's word planted in us which transforms and saves... ///
- Sound hard? Challenging? Searching?
- Absolutely... but the closer we walk with our heavenly Father the more open to the Holy Spirit's transforming work in us we are than we will change.
- There was a lady at a church I was at once who was often cranky with people and quick to criticise...
 people used to keep their distance from her. But the clearer she become about the gospel the
 greater grasp of God's grace she had the more she knew God's character... the slower to become
 angry she became. /
- That can be your testimony too... may **already is**... but open yourself up to God's **work** in your **heart** and see what **he will do**.... ///
- So we stand out because:

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- 3. ... because we listen and do! 1:22-25
- V22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves...
- James is so blunt isn't he!!??
- For example we've just heard that we are to be **quick** to **listen** and slow to **speak** and slow to become **angry**...
- How totally absurd... if we all nod our head and say 'amen' to that... and think that by listening to this
 sermon we've done a great thing... and then go home and lose the plot and raise our voice in anger
 at home having not listened properly to whatever someone has tried to tell us...
- Ridiculous and tragic... and absurd.
- Like looking in the mirror as you left this morning and not doing a thing about that toothpaste around your mouth or shaving cream on your ear...
- But here's the wonderful **flip side** v25 But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.
- Notice the irony the law that gives freedom? We usually think of the law as being restrictive...
 oppressive... but no the word of God the law of God gives freedom because it shows us our we are designed to live.... It sets us free to live God's way....
- And when we look into it and DO what we read... put it into practice in our lives, there is actually
 great blessing... blessing and joy found in living God's way... the only way!
- like the story I read recently of someone who was living way **outside** of God's will... but someone shared God's love with **her** and when she **rejected** the lifestyle she had been **sold** which had actually been full of **misery**, she actually discovered **who she was** and found a **deep and satisfying joy** living **WITHIN** God's will in a way she had never done **OUTSIDE** of **God's will!** ///
- well, finally in this chapter, James gets very **practical**... he tells us what life will be like when we **understand** we are **his**, when we live lives which **stand out**, when we **DO** what his **word** says... and does this by touching on three **examples**:
- 4. ...e.g.: our tongue, our care, and our heart 1:26-27
- v26 Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless.
- Pardon James??
- Yes you heard him... if you consider yourself religious and yet can't control your tongue you're having yourself on -- your religion is worthless...
- Now this is not about you letting out an occasional rude word when you stub your toe...
- This about those who speak down to others, always critical of others, those who spread gossip and rumours, those who tell lies; those who always talking about others behind their backs; those who claim their political views are the only right ones... always having an opinion about everything but never listening to others... that's what he's talking about.
- It's the opposite of what he put before us earlier of being slow to speak and slow to become angry.
 And honestly people who are just like this all the time you do end up wondering if they really walk with Jesus!

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- But he has two more examples: Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
- Care for the most **vulnerable** in **society** especially at a time in the 1st century when there was no social welfare of any kind...
- If your heart is not moved by the plight of those who have **nothing** or **next to nothing**... those who are on the **street**; those who have been **abused**; those who struggle with **addiction**, those who live in alcohol or drug fuelled desperate and abusive **circumstances**...
- Religion that God our Father accepts us pure and faultless.... that is, religion that is the real deal...
 religion that has made a difference, that is transforming you... from the inside out cares for such people... ///
- AND **keeps oneself** from being **polluted** by the **world**...
- I said earlier everywhere we look is pollution I don't mean of the environment I mean of our world's morals and values... and true religion religion that is true because it is about relationship deep and personal relationship with the Lord Jesus will keep a distance from the world's polluted values and morals...!

Friends here is what we've seen in this second half of James chapter 1

- 1. We are his because of him of all God's good gifts, the best is new birth through his Word
- 2. ... therefore, we stand out in this world simply but profoundly because we are quick to listen, slow to speak or become angry and we take a stand against the evil around us.... And we do this because:
- 3. ... because we listen and do! We look into God's word his law which gives freedom and we find great blessing in exploring all God would have us be...
- 4. And by our controlled **tongue**, through our **care** for the **vulnerable**, and by guarding our heart from the **pollution** of the **world**... we show ourselves to be people of **true religion** true **relationship relationship** with **God** through Jesus, which makes a profound **difference** in our **lives**.

Doesn't mince words James, does he!

After this mirror held up to us today, let's take action... let's search our hearts, and let's find freedom and blessing in living God's way.
