"I believe in Christ, risen from the dead

He now reigns victorious, His kingdom knows no end

Through His resurrection, death has lost its hold

I know on that final day, I'll rise as Jesus rose" //

- One line I want to pick up on from those words... which are talking about Jesus...
- He now reigns victorious // His kingdom knows no end
- I want you to imagine I gave you two boxes of sticky labels...
- You know the ones like a roll of postage stamps... only bigger...
- Where you roll out a label and you're able to stick it on something...
- Two boxes and just one word on each label...
- In one box on every label is the word "temporary"
- And the other box on every label is the word "permanent"
- Ok got your boxes ready?
- Now imagine I gave you a task...
- I asked you to go around everything in your house and label it with the appropriate label...
- **Microwave**? Which label...? **Temporary**... Susan and I had to buy a new microwave a couple of months ago... first time I'd been in Harvey Norman for years....
- **TV** temporary
- Mattress temporary
- Fridge temporary how long do they last now? 10 years?
- Dishwasher, toaster, washing machine, stove...
- Sandwich maker; pancake maker (got to love those!)
- Even lounge... and lamp and coffee table...
- Out to the back yard outdoor setting and the BBQ
- Into the garage mower, blower, trimmer, CAR!! //
- Gosh our permanent box hasn't been used at all yet!
- What about the house itself which label will you put on that?

- Yes temporary we used to live in Roseville in Sydney and whenever we go back one more beautiful old home which was someone's haven and sanctuary for years – where beautiful family memories were collected over sometimes more than 100 years – has been knocked down so that another apartment block has been be put up....
- So yes mark your **home** itself as **temporary**....
- and then in the community around you.... What labels would you use?
- That **tree** that's been there forever no someone could take that **out**...
- That beautiful **view** overlooking the mountain no someone could take out by building in front of you or wrecking the view in some other way
- That **park** well who knows?
- The car yards on the corner at **West Bathurst** well no that's now a **McDonalds** and **Subway** and **7/11**....
- The Avis **rental** yard no that's now a Mexican fast-food place....
- Nothing here is permanent!!
- Even Rosehill racecourse in Sydney turns out in the past two weeks that's only temporary...
- What about the government... and government departments?
- No they come and go... and every time there is a new government all the ministries or many of them
 – are changed...
- Anastasia Palaszczuk has resigned... there are now no state premiers remaining who led their states through COVID!
- What about government leaders on the world stage...?
- Even our dear late Queen Elizabeth II has now gone...
- Even our dear late Queen Elizabeth II has now gone...
- AND Putin only temporary President ZI despite the way they've changed their nation's laws to stay on in leadership – they actually won't be around forever
- Temporary temporary temporary
- Everything is temporary only here for a time...
- **EXCEPT**... except...
- What did our song say about Jesus?
- HIS kingdom knows no end!
- Peel off one your 'permanent' labels and stick it on Jesus!
- HIS kingdom knows no end!
- That's a staggering thing we recall at Christmas isn't it?
- That this boy that was born is God visiting our planet as one of us...
- And that he rules the world and will rule the world <u>FOREVER</u>.
- So we sang in the carols...
 - o In our opening carol we shall see him in **heaven**, set at God's right hand on high

- In the second carol come and behold him born the king of angels
- In "O little town of Bethlehem", we sang, "the hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee tonight"
- o Or in "Joy to the world" we sing "The Lord is **come**: let earth receive her **KING**"!!! ///
- Extraordinary things we sing about this little baby born.
- And the notion that his kingdom knows no end, comes to us from the Bible...
- From the prophet Isaiah 700 years before Jesus was even born we read: "

Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end.

He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.

• We read the same concept when the angel first told Mary the astonishing news that she was pregnant...

He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, ³³ and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end."

Or in the Psalms – the hymn book of the Old Testament - 145

Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures through all generations.

Or in the very last book of the Bible – Revelation 11:15

"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and **he will reign for ever and ever."**

- Friends we live in a temporary world where nothing is **permanent**, and few things are **reliable**.
- But we remember at Christmas someone was born who will reign forever and whose kingdom will have no end
- and that means that in the **mess** which is this **world** and often in the **mess** which is our **lives** there is **something someone reliable dependable**...
- whose reign is not marked by terror or oppression or injustice but by love and compassion and truth
 and transparency... mercy... righting eventually all that is wrong with our world and all that is wrong
 with me.
- And this is not just about a vague distant hope for the future... this is about NOW
- For he invites us to love him and know him and live with him and serve him and turn to him and trust him now – in the mess – and he will bind our wounded hearts – and heal our crushed hopes – and mend our trashed lives
- He will put us back together and lead is in the right way
- He will nurture our very souls

- He will change us from the **inside // out**... so we become people of **love and patience and joy and compassion**.... Just as **he is**...
- His Kingdom is NOW and one day he will reign supreme and this Christmas I want you to remember that nothing – nothing here is permanent....
