Series: On that day

Title: We will keep on singing

Passage: Revelation 5:9-13

- I believe in Christ, risen from the dead
 He now reigns victorious, His kingdom knows no end
 Through His resurrection, death has lost its hold
 I know on that final day, I'll rise as Jesus rose
- On that day, we will see You
 Shining brighter than the sun
 On that day, we will know You
 As we lift our voice as one
 'Til that day, we will praise You
 For Your never-ending grace
 And we will keep on singing on that glorious day. ////
- Good to be with you today on the fourth Sunday in Advent...
 and of course because today is also Christmas Eve.... We are
 in danger of losing the concept of Advent looking to Jesus'
 return due to Christmas being so close!

- So I'm glad you're taking this time out to continue our Advent focus.... And we'll just push back on Christmas for a few more hours yet!! //
- So we've been enjoying this great song by CityAlight called "On that Day" - referring of course to that great day of Jesus' return...
- And here are the lines we've picked up on throughout Advent.... The lyrics have recalled – that **ON THAT DAY** we will
 - Rise as Jesus rose;
 - We will see you
 - We will know you //
- And then the lyrics say
- **Until** that day that is today and every day until Jesus' returns... we will praise you for your never-ending grace; AND:
- We'll **keep on singing** on that **glorious day!**

Do you **enjoy** singing and praising **God**??

I hope so – because in eternity – you'll be doing a lot of it!!

- It's one of the repeated descriptions in the Psalms the hymn book of the Bible – and in the last book of the Bible, which regularly describes how people will be gathering around Jesus the lamb of God and singing his praises.
- Let me share a couple of these verses with you
- Psalm 9:2 I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the praises of your name, O Most High
- Or Psalm 47:6-7 Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth; sing to him a psalm of praise.
- **Psalm 95** Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song
- Or 96 Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth. Sing to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day
- Or 145 I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever.
- Or in the Book of the Revelation:
- **5:10** And they sang a new song, saying: 'You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain,

and with your blood, you purchased for God persons from every tribe and language and people and nation

- **Or 7:10** where this great multitude no one could count from every nation, tribe, people and language.... Cried out in a loud voice Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb.
- Or ch 19 various verses Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God ... Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, both great and small!' ...
 'Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns.
- Are you getting the idea that praising God is central to our relationship with him – both now and into the future!?
- And that is because when you know God's character and how he loves us and what he's done for us in the Lord Jesus... the only – the natural – response – is to praise him!
- So here's where we are heading today! Very simply:
 - 1. Something to sing about
 - 2. Someone to sing to

1. Something to sing about

 I received a survey from the NRMA this week because I renewed a car insurance policy.... The first question was

predictably – "how likely on scale of 1 to 10 are you to recommend NRMA to someone else?"

- Now, I always rate that question as the **lowest** possible... and when they ask why, I give the same answer – because I just don't go around recommending things to people!
- I would have to be **really taken really impressed** really excited by something – and really convinced it was going to change someone's life – for me to sing the praises of some product or service...
- But friends when it comes to **God** and all we have from him in the gift of His Son and the promise of a renewed future and a renewed me, I want to tell the world...
- I want to **preach** it from every **pulpit**
- I want to preach here to **video** and share it on social media...
- ...for **friends** in our great and glorious God, we have something to sing about...!!
- in those quotes from the Psalms we are called the sing the praises of the God whose reign is eternal, because he's the great King of all the earth...
- In the songs of the Book of **Revelation**, we are urged to sing the praises of Jesus who is worthy because he has won our salvation through Jesus – the Lamb of God who has taken

away the sins of the world!

- **Remember?** 'You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood, you purchased for God persons from every tribe and language and people and nation" - ch 5
- Yes something to sing about the God who loves us through and through - who has acted to save us through the person of the Lord Jesus Christ... through whose death and resurrection we are welcomed into his eternal presence! ///
- and **secondly**; we

2. Someone to sing to

- our praise isn't just some distant religious act or ritual or chant or mantra.... Given out into space...
- this is **personal**
- it's real
- it's intimate
- we sing to our God who has run out to welcome us home and embrace us
- we praise the one who loved the **world** loved **US** so much he has given his Son

- we sing to our great God who as we'll see in our Lenten studies next year – I really hope you'll make use of them – our great God who is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, forgiving and just!!
- we sing to the one who as we heard last week <u>knows</u> us through and through - and yet loves us any way!
- We sing to the mighty and majestic and very great God who we are privileged to call "Father"! //
- Yes something to sing ABOUT our salvation our forgiveness – won for us by Jesus – and eternity in his presence by his grace....
- And someone to sing TO our compassionate, gracious, faithful, forgiving... good God and heavenly Father and Jesus his Son who has taken away our sin!

Let me close

On that day, we will **see** You
Shining brighter than the sun
On that day, we will **know** You
As we lift our voice as one
'Til that day, we will **praise** You
For Your **never-ending grace**And we will **keep on singing** on that **glorious day**.

- Yes on that day we will rise we will see Jesus we will know God...
- And until that day we will praise you!
- No matter the challenges you're facing in life right now and many are SO significant we can and should and must keep praising God for his love and faithfulness for the gift of His Son and the promise of a future...! //
- Till that day we will praise you....
- And then... then... we'll just <u>keep on</u> singing on that glorious day and our praises will keep going unabated uninterrupted for all eternity....! ///
- Well this is the last of our Advent series... I hope and pray you've captured a sense of the significance of Advent looking forward to eternity the return on Jesus the renewal of all things including our very selves...
- We will rise as Jesus rose
- We will **see** Jesus face to **face**
- We will **know** him even as we are fully **known**
- Till that day we will praise him for his never-ending grace – and then – we'll keep on singing on that glorious day.
- Let's end the series by enjoying the whole song which
