1. What does it mean to have an "all or nothing" commitment to God?
2. How can we ensure that our commitment to God is not just a casual or superficial one?

The Challenge of Joshua

1. How does Joshua's challenge to the Israelites in Joshua 24:14-24 relate to our own lives as Christians?
2. What are some "foreign gods" that we may need to throw away in order to fully commit to God?

The Cost of Following Jesus

1. What does Jesus mean when he says that following him requires denying ourselves and taking up our cross (Mark 8:34)?
2. How can we be prepared to pay the cost of following Jesus in our daily lives?

Accountability and Community

1. Why is it important to have accountability among believers, as mentioned in the sermon?
2. How can we support and encourage one another in our commitment to God?

Throwing Away Foreign Gods

1. What are some things that may be competing for our devotion and attention, and how can we "throw them away"?
2. How can we yield our hearts fully to the Lord and give Him our exclusive devotion?

The Ultimate Solution

1. How does the story of Joshua point us to the ultimate solution to humanity's rebellion, which is found in Jesus?
2. How can we praise God for the salvation and eternal life that we have in Jesus?
3. As we conclude our journey through the book of Joshua, what is the one thing (or two things) that God has been speaking to you about, either through Joshua's conquests, his failures, his final challenges, or God's actions, that you have been challenged by. Or simply – what new thing have you learned?
